Our OFSTED registered venue on the Redhills School site offers children a wide variety of safe and attractive indoor and outdoor play spaces. We also run trips and outings to make the most of every day.

Children from any primary school are welcome.

We are shut between Christmas and new year and a week at Easter.

Sessions cost £10 half day, £18 full day, plus £2.60 for Breakfast club if needed.
